

Acer LCD Monitor Quick Start Guide (QSG)

Important safety instructions

Please read the following instructions carefully.

- To clean the LCD monitor screen:
 - Turn off the LCD monitor and unplug the power cord.
 - Spray a non-solvent cleaning solution onto a rag and clean the screen gently.
- Do not place the LCD monitor near a window. Exposing the monitor to rain, moisture or sunlight can severely damage it.
- Do not apply pressure to the LCD screen. Excessive pressure may cause permanent damage to the display.
- Do not remove the cover or attempt to service this unit yourself. An authorized technician should perform servicing of any nature.
- Store the LCD monitor in a room with a temperature of -20°C to 60°C (-4°F to 140°F). Storing the LCD monitor outside this range may result in permanent damage.
- Immediately unplug your monitor and call an authorized technician if any of the following circumstances occur:
 - Monitor-to-PC signal cable is frayed or damaged.
 - Liquid spills onto the LCD monitor or the monitor is exposed to rain.
 - The LCD monitor or case is damaged.
- In order to prevent damage to the LCD panel, do not place the monitor face down on a surface.

Installing the Monitor Base

- Remove the monitor from the packaging.
- Pick up the monitor, open the leather case, and place it upright on the desktop.

Connecting your monitor

• Type-C Installation

- Connect the monitor to your computer
 - Connect the signal transmission cable (Thunderbolt 3 (USB-C) cable) to the monitor's Type-C jack and the Type-C output jack of the computer's display card.
 - The monitor does not require an external power supply via its Type-C port when it is connected to the computer; it only requires a single signal transmission cable (the Thunderbolt3 (USB-C) cable).
 - Connect USB-C (OTG) peripherals on the right side
 - It can be connected to various USB peripherals (such as mice, keyboards, etc.) through a USB to Type-C cable.
- Connect the screen to your phone
 - Connect the signal transmission cable to the Type-C jack of the monitor and the Type-C output jack on your phone.
 - Some underpowered phones require an external power supply via the monitor's Type-C port when in use.

Note:

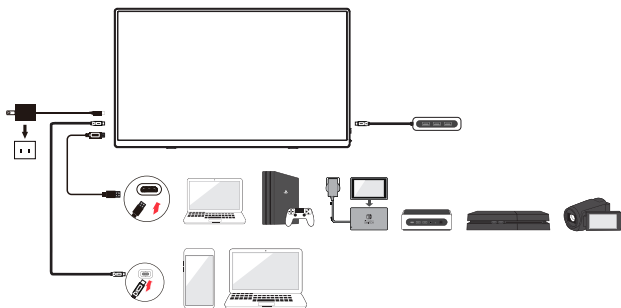
- This monitor can operate normally under 5V=3.0A / PD (5-20V) conditions.
- When the monitor is connected to the phone, it can provide power to the phone (Type-C output: 5V=1A).

• HDMI Installation

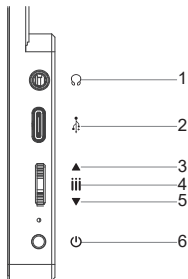
- Connect the monitor to your computer
 - Connect the signal transmission cable HDMI cable to the mini HDMI jack of the monitor and the HDMI output jack of the computer display card.
 - When the monitor is connected to the computer through an HDMI signal cable, it needs to provide an external power (5V=3.0A / PD (5-20V)) supply through its Type-C port; A signal transmission cable (Thunderbolt3(USB-C) cable) is required.
- Connect to other devices via HDMI port
 - Connect the signal transmission cable HDMI cable to the mini HDMI jack of the monitor and the HDMI output jack of other devices.
 - When the monitor is connected to other devices through an HDMI signal cable, it needs to provide external power (5V=3.0A / PD (5-20V)) through its Type-C port; A signal transmission cable (Thunderbolt3(USB-C) cable) is required.

Note:

This monitor can operate normally under 5V=3.0A / PD (5-20V) conditions.

Icon	Item	Description
	Audio out	3.5mm Headphone hole: This connection is for audio out from the monitor to multimedia speakers or headphones.
	USB-C (OTG)	USB-C (OTG) connection to peripheralsIt can be connected to various USB peripherals (such as mouse, keyboards, etc.) through a USB to Type-C cable.
	Up	Press this button to select the desired item when in OSD menu.
	Menu	Press this key to open OSD.
	Down	Press this button to select the desired item when in OSD menu.
	Power On/Off	Long press for more than 3 seconds to turn on and off the display.
