
Connect your PC to your ViewSonic LCD Display

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4 Watching Your LCD display

Adjust Display Mode

Your ViewSonic LCD display supports several aspect ratios.

For best viewing, select the appropriate **Zoom Mode** to suit the viewing display. The **16:9** aspect ratio looks perfect on your ViewSonic LCD display. For different aspect ratio, press on your remote control and select **Picture > Zoom Mode** to change.

Customize Picture Mode

ViewSonic LCD display includes several preset view options optimized for different viewing conditions. Press P.MODE on your remote control, or press 🏠 on your remote control and select PICTURE > Picture Mode. Choose the appropriate mode to suit your content.
