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# ASSEMBLING AND PREPARING

## CAUTION

- Always use genuine LG components to ensure safety and product performance.
- The product warranty will not cover damage or injury caused by the use of unauthorized components.
- It is recommended that use the supplied components.
- The product figures and screen displays used in this manual are examples to help consumers use the product and may differ from the actual product.
- Do not apply foreign substances (oils, lubricants, etc.) to the screw parts when assembling the product. (Doing so may damage the product.)
- Applying excessive force when tightening screws may cause damage to the monitor. Damage caused in this way will not be covered by the product warranty.
- Do not carry the monitor upside down by just holding the base. This may cause the monitor to fall off the stand and could result in personal injury.
- When lifting or moving the monitor, do not touch the monitor screen. The force applied to the monitor screen may cause damage to it.
- For wave pattern on appearance, unlike the general method of coating, it's applied to added glittering material in raw material. With no peeled-off appearance, it has good durability. Please use it with confidence because there is no problem in using the product at all.

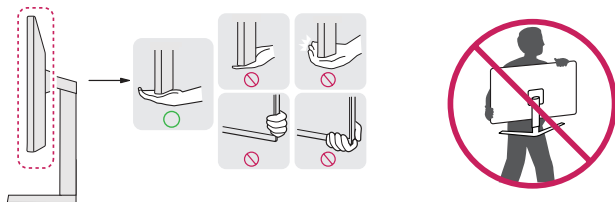

# Installing

## Moving and Lifting the Monitor

When moving or lifting the monitor, follow these instructions to prevent the monitor from being scratched or damaged and to ensure safe transportation, regardless of its shape or size.

- Before moving or lifting the monitor, disconnect the power cord and all other cables.
- Place the monitor in the original box or packing material before attempting to move it.
- Hold the bottom and side of the monitor frame firmly. Do not hold the panel itself.
- When holding the monitor, the screen should face away from you to prevent it from being scratched.
- When transporting the monitor, do not expose the monitor to shock or excessive vibration.
- When moving the monitor, keep it upright and never turn the monitor on its side or tilt it sideways.

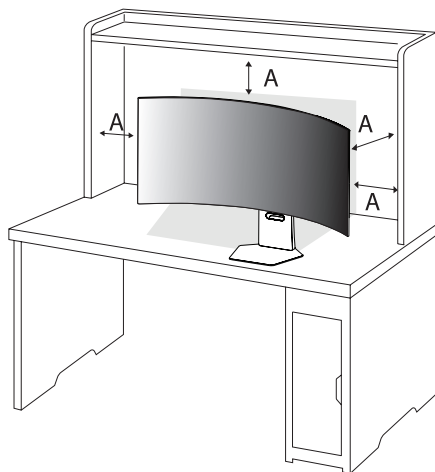


### CAUTION

- Avoid touching the monitor screen as much as possible.
  - This may result in damage to the screen or some of the pixels used to create images.

## Installing on a Table

- Lift the monitor and place it on the table in an upright position. Place the monitor at least 100 mm (3.9 inches) away from the wall to ensure sufficient ventilation.



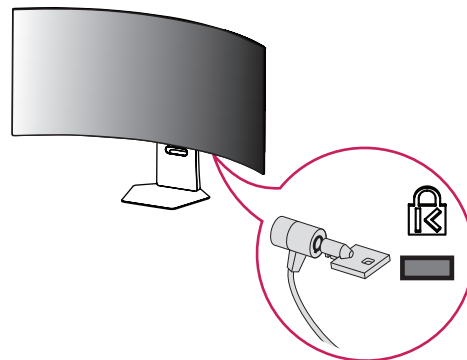
A: 100 mm (3.9 inches)

### CAUTION

- Unplug the power cord before moving or installing the monitor. There is risk of electric shock.
- Make sure to use the power cord that is provided in the product package and connect it to a grounded power outlet. (Depending on country)
- If you need another power cord, please contact your local dealer or the nearest retail store.

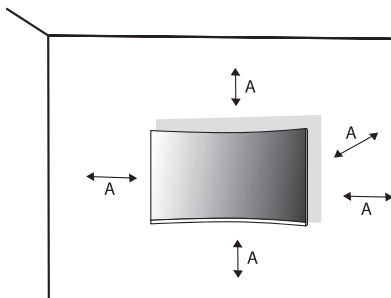

Installing on the Wall

This monitor meets the specifications for the wall mount plate or other compatible devices. Install the monitor at least 100 mm (3.9 inches) away from the wall and leave about 100 mm (3.9 inches) of space at each side of the monitor to ensure sufficient ventilation. Detailed installation instructions can be obtained from your local retail store. Alternatively, please refer to the manual for how to install and set up a tilting wall mounting bracket.

Installing the Wall Mount Plate

To install the monitor to a wall, attach a wall mounting bracket (optional) to the back of the monitor. Make sure that the wall mounting bracket is securely fixed to the monitor and to the wall.

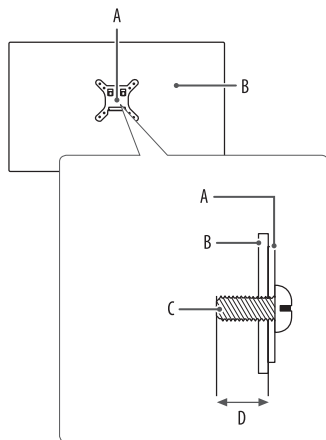
- Use the screws specified by VESA standards.
- The wall mount kit includes the installation guide and all necessary parts.
- The wall mounting bracket is optional. You can obtain optional accessories from your local dealer.
- The length of the screw may differ for each wall mounting bracket. If you use screws longer than the standard length, it may damage the inside of the product.
- For more information, please refer to the user manual for the wall mounting bracket.
- Be careful not to apply too much force while mounting the wall mount plate as it may cause damage to the screen.
- Remove the stand before installing the monitor on a wall mount by performing the stand attachment in reverse.

**CAUTION**

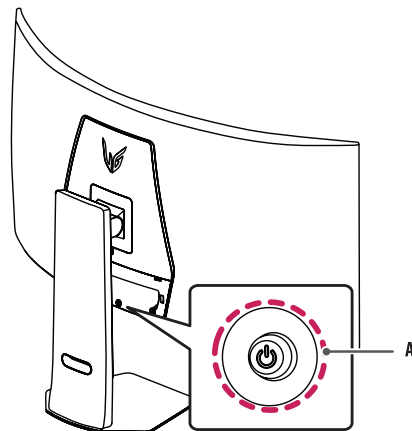
- Unplug the power cord before moving or installing the monitor to avoid electric shock.
- Installing the monitor on the ceiling or on a slanted wall may result in the monitor falling off, which could lead to injury. Use an authorized LG wall mount and contact the local dealer or qualified personnel.
- To prevent injury, this apparatus must be securely attached to the wall in accordance with the installation instructions.
- Applying excessive force when tightening screws may cause damage to the monitor. Damage caused in this way will not be covered by the product warranty.
- Use the wall mounting bracket and screws that conform to VESA standards. Damage caused by the use or misuse of inappropriate components will not be covered by the product warranty.
- When measured from the back of the monitor, the length of each installed screw must be 8 mm (0.3 inches) or less.

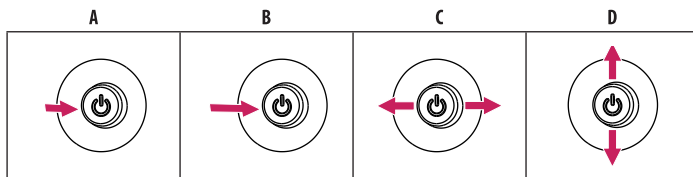


A: Joystick Button

## How to Use the Joystick Button

You can easily control the functions of the monitor by pressing the joystick button or moving it left/right/up/down with your finger.

### Basic Functions



**A (Power on):** Press the joystick button once with your finger to turn on the monitor.

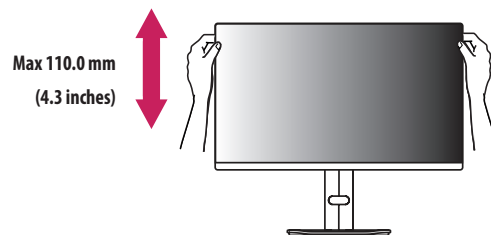
**B (Power off):** Press and hold the joystick button once for more than 5 seconds with your finger to turn off the monitor.

**C (Volume control):** You can control the volume by moving the joystick button left/right.

**D:** Enters the [Accessibility] menu.

## Adjusting the Stand Height

- 1 Place the monitor mounted on the stand base in an upright position.
- 2 Handle the monitor with both hands for safety.



### ⚠ WARNING

- When adjusting the screen height, do not place your hand on the stand body to avoid injury to your fingers.

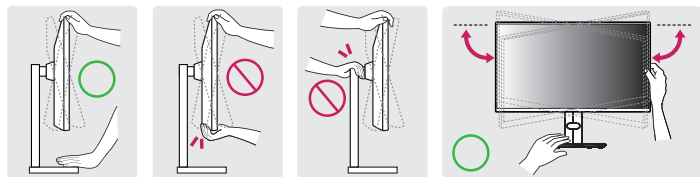
## Adjusting the Angle

- 1 Place the monitor mounted on the stand base in an upright position.
- 2 Adjust the angle of the screen.

The angle of the screen can be adjusted forward or backward from  $-9^{\circ}$  to  $13^{\circ}$  for a comfortable viewing experience. And you can also adjust the angle of the screen by 30 degrees to the left or to the right.

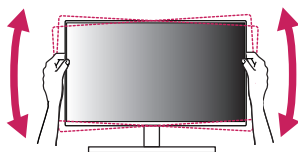
### WARNING

- To avoid injury to the fingers when adjusting the screen, do not hold the lower part of the monitor's frame as illustrated below.
- Be careful not to touch or press the screen area when adjusting the angle of the monitor.



### NOTE

- The left or right side of the monitor head can be slightly rotated up or down. Adjust the horizontal level of the monitor head.

## USING THE MONITOR

- Illustrations in this manual may differ from the actual product.
- Press the joystick button, go to [Settings] > [Input], and then select the input option.

### CAUTION

- If you use generic cables not certified by LG, the screen may not display or there may be image noises.
- Do not press the screen for a prolonged time. This may cause image distortion.
- Do not display a still image on the screen for a prolonged time. This may cause image retention. Use a PC screensaver if possible.
- When connecting the power cord to the outlet, use a grounded (3-hole) power strip or a grounded power outlet.
- The monitor may flicker when turned on in an area where the temperature is low. This is normal.
- Sometimes red, green, or blue spots may appear on the screen. This is normal.
- Make sure to use the supplied cable of the product. Otherwise, this may cause the device to malfunction.
- If the monitor is reflecting environmental light, move the monitor or light or adjust the strength of the environmental light.

## Connecting to a PC

- This monitor supports the Plug and Play\* feature.
- \* Plug and Play: A feature that allows you to add a device to your computer without having to reconfigure anything or install any manual drivers.

### HDMI Connection

Transmits digital video and audio signals from your PC to the monitor.

### NOTE

- Using a DVI to HDMI / DP (DisplayPort) to HDMI cable may cause compatibility issues.
- Use a certified cable with the HDMI logo attached. If you do not use a certified HDMI cable, the screen may not display or a connection error may occur.
- Recommended HDMI cable types
  - Ultra High Speed HDMI®/™ cable
  - Ultra High Speed HDMI®/™ cable with Ethernet

## DisplayPort Connection

Transmits digital video and audio signals from your PC to the monitor.

### ! NOTE

- There may be no video or audio output depending on the DP (DisplayPort) version of the PC.
- If you are using a Mini DisplayPort output graphics card, use a Mini DP to DP (Mini DisplayPort to DisplayPort) cable or gender that supports DisplayPort1.4. (Sold separately)

## USB-C Connection

Transmits digital video and audio signals from your PC to the monitor.

### ! NOTE

- PD (Power Delivery) and DP Alternate Mode (DP over USB-C) are supported via USB-C Port.
- Features may not work properly depending on the connected device's specifications and the environment.
- USB-C port is not for the monitor power source but for a PC power source. Connect adapter to supply power to the monitor.

## Connecting AV Devices

### HDMI Connection

HDMI transmits digital video and audio signals from your AV device to the monitor.

### ! NOTE

- Using a DVI to HDMI / DP (DisplayPort) to HDMI cable may cause compatibility issues.
- Use a certified cable with the HDMI logo attached. If you do not use a certified HDMI cable, the screen may not display or a connection error may occur.
- Recommended HDMI cable types
  - Ultra High Speed HDMI®/™ cable
  - Ultra High Speed HDMI®/™ cable with Ethernet

## Connecting Peripherals

### USB Device connection

The USB port on the product functions as a USB hub.

#### ! NOTE

- It is recommended you install all Windows Updates to keep your Windows up-to-date before connecting to the product for use.
- Peripheral devices are sold separately.
- A keyboard, mouse, or USB device can be connected to the USB port.
- The charging speed may vary depending on the device.
- To use USB Downstream port of monitor, user must connect Upstream port of monitor to Host PC using USB C-C or USB C-A cable.
- Connecting a USB-C input to the host PC enables the monitor downstream port to support a USB 2.0 device.
- Connecting a **SS**  port to the host PC enables the monitor downstream port to support a USB 3.0 device. Note that the host PC must support the USB 3.0 function.

#### ! CAUTION

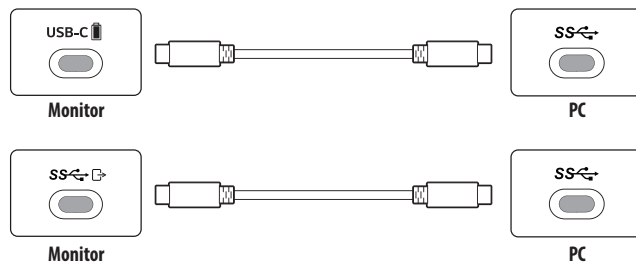
- Cautions when using a USB device.
  - A USB device with an automatic recognition program installed, or that uses its own driver, may not be recognized.
  - Some USB devices may not be supported or may not work properly.
  - It is recommended to use a USB hub or hard disk drive with power supplied. (If the power supply is not adequate, the USB device may not be recognized properly.)

### Headset Connection

Connect peripherals to the monitor via the headset port.

#### ! NOTE

- Peripheral devices are sold separately.
- Depending on the audio settings of the PC and external device, headset and speaker functions may be limited.
- The microphone works only when the USB port on the monitor is connected to the USB port on the PC. Please connect the USB C-C or USB C-A cable to use a microphone function with headphones equipped with a microphone.



- If you use angled earphones, it may cause a problem with connecting another external device to the monitor. Therefore, it is recommended to use straight earphones.

- When [Beep Guide] is activated, pressing the joystick button will take you to [Settings] right away.

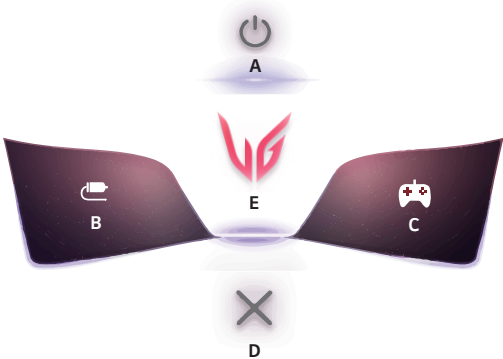
## Activating the Main Menu

## Menu Settings

- 1 To view the OSD menu, press the joystick button and then enter the [Settings].
- 2 Move the joystick up/down and left/right to set the options.
- 3 To return to the upper menu or set other menu items, move the joystick to < or press (👉) it.
- 4 If you want to exit the OSD menu, move the joystick to < until you exit.

## [Game Adjust]

### [Settings] > [Game Adjust]

- [Game Adjust]: You can select picture modes for game display settings.
  - [Gamer 1]/[Gamer 2]: [Gamer 1] and [Gamer 2] picture modes allow you to save two sets of customized display settings, including game-related setup options.
  - [FPS]: This mode is optimized for FPS games. It is suitable for very dark FPS games.
  - [RTS]: This mode is optimized for RTS Game.
  - [Vivid]: Optimized the screen for vivid colors.
  - [Reader]: Optimizes the screen for reading documents. You can brighten the screen in the OSD menu. (for SDR only)
  - [HDR Effect]: Optimizes the screen for high dynamic range. (for SDR only)
  - [sRGB]: A standard RGB color space for the monitor and printer. (for SDR only)
  - [DCI-P3]: Suitable for watching digital videos. (for SDR only)
  - [Color Weakness]: This mode is for users who cannot distinguish between red and green. It enables users with color weakness to easily distinguish between the two colors. (for SDR only)
    - » This is subsidiary for color weakness user. Therefore, if you feel uncomfortable with the screen, please turn off this function.
    - » This function can't distinguish some colors in some images.



**NOTE**

- The [Game Mode] can be set depends on the Input signal.
- If the [Game Mode] is changed in the DP (DisplayPort) input, the screen may flicker or the resolution of your PC screen may be affected.
- HDR content may not display correctly depending on Windows OS settings, please check HDR On/Off settings in Windows.
- When the HDR function is turned on, the characters or picture quality may be poor according to Graphic card performance.
- While the HDR function is on, screen flickering or cracking may occur when changing the monitor input or power on/off according to Graphic card performance.
- For information about whether the graphics card and game support HDR, visit their manufacture's website.

- [Adaptive-Sync]/[VRR]: This function shows a clear screen without screen tearing or stuttering in the game environment.

However, screen flickering may occur in some game environments.

- Supported Interface: DisplayPort (Adaptive-Sync), HDMI (VRR).
- Supported Graphic Card: A graphic card that supports AMD's FreeSync is necessary.
- Supported Version: Make sure to update the graphic card to the latest driver.
- For more information and requirement, refer to AMD website ([www.amd.com](http://www.amd.com)).

- [Black Stabilizer]: You can control the black contrast to have better visibility in dark scenes. You can easily distinguish objects on dark game screens.

- [Response Time]: Sets a response time for displayed pictures based on the speed of the screen.

For a normal environment, it is recommended that you use [Fast].

For a fast-moving picture, it is recommended that you use [Faster].

Setting to [Faster] may cause image sticking.

- [Faster]: Sets the response time to Faster.
- [Fast]: Sets the response time to Fast.
- [Normal]: Sets the response time to Normal.
- [Off]: Disables the feature.

- [Crosshair]: Crosshair provides a mark on the center of the screen for First Person Shooter (FPS) games. Users can select the crosshair that fits their gaming environment among four different crosshairs.
- [FPS Counter]
  - [On]: The indicator is displayed on the upper left of the screen. It will reflect the actual frame rate that is received at the input. You can also adjust the position of FPS Counter. (upper left/ upper right/ lower right/ lower left)
  - [Off]: Does not use the FPS Counter feature.
  - [FPS Counter] and [Crosshair] feature can not be used at the same time.
- [Game Reset]: Returns game to the default settings.

## [Picture Adjust]

### [Settings] > [Picture Adjust]

- [Brightness]: Adjusts the brightness of the screen.
- [Contrast]: Adjusts the color contrast of the screen.
- [Sharpness]: Adjusts the sharpness of the screen.
- [Gamma]
  - [Mode 1], [Mode 2], [Mode 3]: The higher the gamma value, the darker the image becomes. Likewise, the lower the gamma value, the lighter the image becomes.
  - [Mode 4]: If you do not need to adjust the gamma settings, select [Mode 4].
- [Color Temp]: Set your own color temperature.
  - [Custom]: The user can customize the red, green and blue color.
  - [Warm]: Sets the screen color to a reddish tone.
  - [Medium]: Sets the screen color to between a red and blue tone.
  - [Cool]: Sets the screen color to a bluish tone.
  - [Manual]: The user can fine-tune the color temperature.
- [R/G/B]: You can customize the picture color using red, green, and blue colors.
- [Six Color]: Meets the user requirements for colors by adjusting the saturation of the six colors (red, green, blue, cyan, magenta, and yellow) and then saving the settings.
  - Hue: Adjusts the tone of the screen colors.
  - Saturation: Adjusts the saturation of the screen colors. The lower the value, the less saturated. The higher the value, the more saturated.

- [Black Level]: Sets the offset level (for HDMI only).  
Offset: as a reference for a video signal, this is the darkest color the monitor can display.
  - [High]: Keeps the current contrast ratio of the screen.
  - [Low]: Lowers the black levels and raises the white levels from the current contrast ratio of the screen.
- [Local Dimming]: Maximizes the contrast ratio by making the bright areas of the screen brighter and the dark areas of the screen darker. Turning this option off may increase energy consumption.
- [Picture Reset]: Returns picture and color to the default settings.

## [Sound]

### [Settings] > [Sound]

- [Sound Out]: Changes the desired audio output method.
- [DepthSound]: Enhances low-frequency richness and improves the listening experience through built-in speakers.
- [Volume]: Adjusts the volume level.
  - You can adjust [Mute] / [Unmute] by moving the joystick button to ✓ in the [Volume] menu.

## [Input]

### [Settings] > [Input]

- [Input List]: Selects the input mode.
- [Aspect Ratio]: Adjusts the aspect ratio of the screen.
  - [Full Wide]: Displays the video in widescreen, regardless of the video signal input.
  - [Original]: Displays video according to the aspect ratio of the video signal input.
  - [Just Scan]: The aspect ratio is not adjusted from the original.
- [Auto Input Switch]: When [Auto Input Switch] is set to [On], display will automatically switch to new input when connected.

## [General]

### [Settings] > [General]

- [Language]: Sets the menu screen to the desired language.
- [USB-C Option]: Set the USB-C settings to be optimized for screen resolution or USB data rate.
- [Hexagon Lighting]: Sets the lighting on the back of the monitor.
  - [Static 1], [Static 2], [Static 3], [Static 4]: Sets the lighting to the desired color.
  - [Cycling]: All colors appear alternately.
  - [Off]: Turns off the light on the back of the monitor.
- [User-defined Key 1]/ [User-defined Key 2]: You can customize the main menu to access your preferred menu easily. [User-defined Key 1] and [User-defined Key 2] appear at the left/right of the main menu.
- [SMART ENERGY SAVING]: Conserve energy by using luminance compensation algorithm.
  - [High]: Saves energy using the high-efficiency [SMART ENERGY SAVING] feature.
  - [Low]: Saves energy using the low-efficiency [SMART ENERGY SAVING] feature.
  - [Off]: Disables the feature.
  - The value of energy saving data may differ depending on panel and panel suppliers.
  - If you select the option of [SMART ENERGY SAVING] as [High] or [Low], monitor luminance become higher or lower depend on source.
- [Deep Sleep Mode]: When Deep sleep mode is enabled, power consumption is minimized while the monitor is in standby mode.
- [Power LED]: When the Power LED function is turned on, it operates as follows:
  - On Mode: Light up
  - Sleep Mode (Standby Mode): Blinking
  - Off Mode: Off
- [Automatic Standby]: If there is no operation on the monitor for a certain period of time, the monitor will automatically switch to standby mode.
- [Input Compatibility Version]: You can set each input to match the supported version of the connected device.
  - If the connected device supports 2.1 in HDMI but the screen or sound does not work properly, set this function to 2.1 (AV).
- [Buzzer]: This feature lets you set the sound generated from Buzzer when your monitor powers on.
- [OSD Lock]: This feature disables the configuration and adjustment of menus.  
All features are disabled except:
  - [Brightness] / [Contrast] in [Picture Adjust]
  - [Input]
  - [Volume] in [Sound]
  - [OSD Lock] / [Information] / [Open Source Software License] in [General]
- [Screen Self-diagnosis]: Checks for any problems with the monitor image. Do not unplug the input cable.
- [Sound Self-diagnosis]: Checks for any problems with the monitor sound. If [Sound Out] is set to [H/P Out], this feature is disabled. Do not unplug the input cable.
- [Information]: The following display information will be shown; [Total Power On Time], [Resolution].
- [Open Source Software License]: If you select the [View], you can check the Open Source Software notice information.
- [Reset to Initial Settings]: Returns to the default settings.

- Is the [No Signal] message being displayed?

- Is the [Out of Range] message being displayed?

IN ARBITRATION, CLASS ACTIONS AND JURY TRIALS ARE NOT PERMITTED. PLEASE SEE THE SECTION TITLED "PROCEDURE FOR RESOLVING DISPUTES" BELOW.

## PROCEDURE FOR RESOLVING DISPUTES:

ALL DISPUTES BETWEEN YOU AND LG ARISING OUT OF OR RELATING IN ANY WAY TO THIS LIMITED WARRANTY OR THE PRODUCT SHALL BE RESOLVED EXCLUSIVELY THROUGH BINDING ARBITRATION, AND NOT IN A COURT OF GENERAL JURISDICTION. BINDING ARBITRATION MEANS THAT YOU AND LG ARE EACH WAIVING THE RIGHT TO A JURY TRIAL AND TO BRING OR PARTICIPATE IN A CLASS ACTION.

**Definitions.** For the purposes of this section, references to "LG" mean LG Electronics U.S.A., Inc., its parents, subsidiaries and affiliates, and each of their officers, directors, employees, agents, beneficiaries, predecessors in interest, successors, assigns and suppliers; references to "dispute" or "claim" shall include any dispute, claim or controversy of any kind whatsoever (whether based in contract, tort, statute, regulation, ordinance, fraud, misrepresentation or any other legal or equitable theory) arising out of or relating in any way to the sale, condition or performance of the product or this Limited Warranty.

**Notice of Dispute.** In the event you intend to commence an arbitration proceeding, you must first notify LG in writing at least 30 days in advance of initiating the arbitration by sending a letter to LG at LG Electronics, USA, Inc. Attn: Legal Department- Arbitration 111 Sylvan Avenue, Englewood Cliffs, NJ 07632. You and LG agree to engage in good faith discussions in an attempt to amicably resolve your claim. The notice must provide your name, address, and telephone number; identify the product that is the subject of the claim; and describe the nature of the claim and the relief being sought. If you and LG are unable to resolve the dispute within 30 days, either party may proceed to file a claim for arbitration.

**Agreement to Binding Arbitration and Class Action Waiver.** Upon failure to resolve the dispute during the 30 day period after sending written notice to LG, you and LG agree to resolve any claims between us only by binding arbitration on an individual basis, unless you opt out as provided below. Any dispute between you and LG shall not be combined or consolidated with a dispute involving any other person's or entity's product or claim. **Fees/Costs.** You do not need to pay any fee to begin an arbitration. Except as otherwise provided for herein, LG will pay all AAA filing, administration and arbitrator fees for any arbitration initiated in accordance with the AAA Rules and this arbitration provision. If you prevail in the arbitration, LG will pay your attorneys' fees and expenses as long as they are reasonable, by considering factors including, but not limited to, the purchase amount and claim amount. 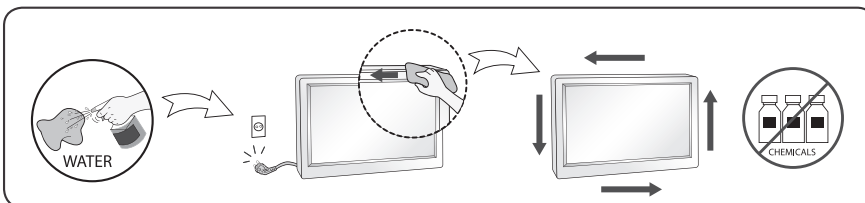

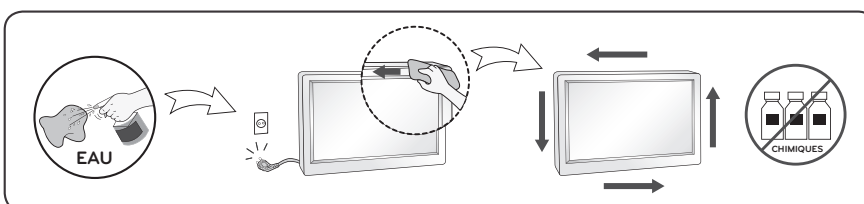

## ITALIANO

### Manutenzione

Staccare il monitor dalla presa elettrica e consultare il personale addetto alla manutenzione quando:

- Il cavo elettrico o la spina sono danneggiati o consumati.
- Si è rovesciato del liquido sul monitor.
- Il monitor è stato esposto alla pioggia o all'acqua.
- Il monitor non funziona correttamente secondo le istruzioni operative. Regolare unicamente quei controlli contemplati nelle istruzioni operative. La manomissione di altri controlli può provocare danni e spesso poi è necessario un lungo lavoro da parte dei tecnici specializzati per ripristinare le normali funzionalità del monitor.
- Il monitor è caduto o si è danneggiata la struttura.
- Il monitor funziona in maniera evidentemente diversa da prima. Il monitor lampeggia in maniera continua o frequente mentre è in funzione. E' normale che alcuni monitor emettano suoni occasionali quando vengono accesi o spenti, oppure quando si cambia la modalità video.

Non cercare di effettuare da soli la manutenzione poiché l'apertura della struttura potrebbe esporre l'utente al pericolo di scariche elettriche o ad altri rischi. Rivolgersi al personale tecnico qualificato.

## ESPAÑOL

### Servicio

Desconecte el monitor del tomacorriente de la pared y refiera el servicio a personal de servicio calificado cuando:

- El cable o enchufe de energía está dañado o desgastado.
- Se ha derramado líquido en el monitor.
- El monitor ha sido expuesto a la lluvia o al agua.
- El monitor no funciona normal aunque se hayan seguido las instrucciones de operación. Ajuste sólo los controles que están cubiertos en las instrucciones de operación. Un ajuste incorrecto de estos controles pueden causar daño y a veces requiere de trabajo extenso por un técnico calificado para restaurar el monitor al funcionamiento normal.
- El monitor se ha dejado caer o el gabinete se ha dañado.
- El monitor exhibe un cambio distinto en la ejecución.
- Los chasquidos o explosivos que emanan del monitor son continuos o frecuentes mientras el monitor está operando. Los ruidos ocasionales son normales para algunos monitores cuando se prende o se apaga, o cambia el modo de video.

No trate de arreglar usted mismo el monitor, ya que abrir y sacar las tapas pueden exponerlo a niveles de voltaje peligrosos u otros peligros. Refiera el arreglo a un personal técnico calificado para ello.

## PORTUGUÊS

### Manutenção

Desligue o monitor da tomada e procure por serviço autorizado, quando:

- O cabo de força ou plugue estiver danificado ou rompido.
- Houve queda de líquido no monitor.
- O monitor foi exposto à chuva ou água.
- O monitor não opera normalmente seguindo as instruções de operação. Ajuste somente os controles descritos nas instruções de operação. Uma tentativa de ajuste de outros controles invalidará a garantia, além de exigir diversas horas de trabalho de pessoal qualificado para restaurar as condições originais de funcionamento do monitor.
- O monitor caiu ou está com o gabinete quebrado.
- O monitor exibe uma distinta mudança de performance.
- O monitor emite estalos ou estouros continuamente durante sua operação normal. Para alguns monitores é normal se ouvirem estalos quando se liga ou desliga o monitor ou quando há mudança de modo de vídeo.

Não tente efetuar a manutenção do monitor você mesmo. Abrir ou remover as tampas do gabinete deixarão expostos pontos de alta tensão em diversas partes do monitor. Procure sempre pessoal qualificado para execução de serviços de manutenção.

## NEDERLANDS

### Onderhoud

In de volgende gevallen haalt u de stekker van de monitor uit het stopcontact en roept u de hulp in van een gekwalificeerde technicus:

- Het netsnoer of de stekker is beschadigd of versleten.
- Er is vloeistof in de monitor gemorst.
- De monitor heeft blootgestaan aan regen of water.
- De monitor werkt niet goed, ondanks het feit dat u handelt volgens de gebruiksaanwijzing. Beperk u bij het instellen van de monitor tot de items die in de gebruiksaanwijzing worden besproken. Het onjuist instellen van andere items kan storingen veroorzaken. Vaak is dan een omvangrijke reparatie door een gekwalificeerde technicus nodig, om de monitor weer voor normaal gebruik in gereedheid te brengen.
- De monitor is gevallen of de behuizing is beschadigd.
- De monitor functioneert wezenlijk anders dan normaal het geval is.
- De monitor produceert voortdurend of regelmatig kraak- en knalgeluiden. Bij sommige monitoren is het normaal dat ze af en toe geluiden produceren bij het in- en uitschakelen, of wanneer ze veranderen van videomodus.

Probeer de monitor niet zelf te repareren, aangezien u bij het openen of verwijderen van de behuizing blootgesteld kunt worden aan gevaarlijke elektrische schokken of andere gevaren. Laat alle reparatiewerkzaamheden over aan gekwalificeerde technici.

### Ремонт и Обслуживание

В нижеперечисленных случаях отключите монитор от сети и обратитесь в пункты сервисного обслуживания:

- Если Вы повредили кабель питания или вилку.
- Если Вы пролили в монитор какую-нибудь жидкость.
- Если монитор подвергся воздействию воды или дождя.
- Если монитор не работает согласно нормативам, указанным в Инструкции. При этом используйте для регулировки только те кнопки управления, которые предлагаются пользователю в Инструкции.
