# Move to the Installation Site



Use a pallet jack or a forklift to move the Modular PDU. Lift only from the bottom. Do not use a forklift if the Modular PDU has been removed from its pallet.

### NOTICE

 Leaving the equipment uncovered and exposed to the elements will cause damage and void the factory warranty.

When possible, leave the equipment on the pallet until you are ready to move it to its final location

If the height of the enclosure exceeds the height of the doorway, remove the enclosure from the pallet.

After the unit has been removed from the pallet, move it only by rolling it on the casters.

Ensure that the floor is level. The unit must be installed on a level floor.

## Receiving

#### **External inspection**

## Unpacking



If the system is not being installed immediately, do not remove the packaging. Store the system in an indoor, temperature-controlled area, free of conductive contaminants.

> A minimum of two people are required to control the unit as it rolls down the ramp. One person should be on either side of the ramp. Ensure a clear area around the pallet and the ramp as an escape route in the event the unit were to tip over.



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#### Level the Modular PDU





- 1 Cut the straps and the plastic wrap 2 Remove the cardboard cover, the along the edges, and remove the plastic.
  - corner protection, the plastic bag, and set the ramp aside.



- 3 Remove the bolts securing the transport brackets to the pallet on the front and back of the enclosure.
- Loosen the bolts which secure the transport brackets to the enclosure, slide the brackets up and re-tighten the bolts.



- Align the hook-and-loop tape strips on the ramp to the front of the pallet.
- Roll the Modular PDU to its final location.

- Use the supplied wrench to lower the four levelling feet to the floor. 2 You can also use a3 Phillips head screwdriver or drill bit inserted into the levelling feet screw heads.
- Make adjustments to ensure the PDU is completely level and properly aligned for joining with the neighbouring equipment. The joining holes on both enclosures must be set on a horizontal plane.

# **Documentation Storage**

#### Attach the stabilizing brackets

After moving the Modular PDU to its final location, install the brackets (provided) to stabilize the unit. The unit should also be joined on at least one side to other equipment in the row. See the next section, "Join the Modular PDU in the row" below.



- **1** Drill a hole in the floor for floor anchoring. Align to the mounting hole in the PDU.
- 2 Place the stabilizing bracket over both holes.
