#### Recognised commands

HP Accessibility Assistant will support around 170 English voice commands for devices configured in English, including these commonly used words and phrases.

To copy, specify the number of copies to make (from 1–99) and say:

"<number> copies," "copies <number>,"
"<number> copy," or "copy <number>."

To set the number of sides of the page to use, say:

"two-sided," "double-sided," "duplex," "one-sided," "single-sided," or "simplex."

To choose paper size, say:

"match original size," "automatic size," "letter," "legal," "eleven by seventeen," "ledger," or "twelve by eighteen."

To set the staple option, say: "staple off" or "staple" (staples in the top-left corner).

To specify the sides of a page to scan, say: "two-sided original," "duplex original," "double-sided original," "one-sided original," or "single-sided original."

To select the paper type, say: "plain" or "letterhead."

To collate or uncollate, say: "collate," "collated," "collate off," or "collated off."

To choose black-and-white or colour, say: "colour," "black," "automatically detect colour," or "automatic colour."

To select a specific tray, say: "tray <number>," "manual feed," or "automatically select tray."

To optimise for text or picture, say: "optimise text" or "optimise picture."

For sizing adjustments, say: "scale <number> percent" (from 1–999%).

To specify the original document's size, say: "original any size," "original letter," "original legal," "original eleven-by-seventeen," "original ledger," or "original twelve by eighteen."

To toggle edge-to-edge, say: "edge-to-edge" or "edge-to-edge off."

To toggle high contrast, say: "high contrast on" or "high contrast off."

To invert colours, say: "invert colours on" or "invert colours off."

For a screen zoom, say: "screen zoom off" or "screen zoom <number> percent" (125, 150, or 200 percent).

To toggle screen reader, say: "screen reader on" or "screen reader off."

To control the sound volume, say: "volume to <number>" or "volume <number>" (from one to ten).
