User Guide

Thank you for purchasing Griffin PowerBlock.

PowerBlock lets you charge and power your iPod® or iPhone™ directly from an AC wall outlet. PowerBlock also works for other devices that can charge through a USB connection, and can work with any AC current from 100V to 240V.

This package includes a charge/sync cable that can be used separately to connect your iPod or iPhone to your computer, but PowerBlock is not limited to use with iPod/iPhone: it can also be used with many other devices that get power through a USB connection. Please check your USB device's documentation to find out more about its charging requirements.

Using PowerBlock

- 1. Plug PowerBlock directly into your AC wall outlet. PowerBlock's nonpolarized blades can be used with most common 100 to 240 Volt outlets
- 2. To charge iPod models that use the Apple Dock Connector, including iPhone, plug the included charge/sync cable into PowerBlock's USB port, and plug the other end into your iPod/iPhone.
- 3. Second generation iPod shuffle can be connected using the original charge/sync cable that came with it.




Charge Indicator Light •

When you plug PowerBlock into an AC outlet, its LED will glow green.

PowerBlock's LED changes to amber when it is charging a connected device, and changes back to green when charging is complete.

Note: While PowerBlock can charge and power first and second generation iPod shuffle, PowerBlock's LED is not an accurate gauge of these batteries' charge level. Consult your iPod shuffle, itself, for accurate level of charge.


