

#### Rear view of tablet holder






#### Introduction


The STNDTBLT1A5T includes a universal tablet holder that accommodates most tablets and a tripod floor stand to provide a stable base for the tablet holder to sit on. The STNDTBLT1A5T also comes with a carrying case, making it convenient to transport the tablet stand or store it when it's not in use.



Dimensions of tripod when it's not extended and the tablet holder is attached




Dimensions of tripod when it's extended and the tablet holder is attached




# Assemble the tripod

1. Hold the tripod pole and turn the knob on the tripod to the left to loosen the legs on the tripod stand.



2. Pull out all three of the legs and turn the knob on the tripod to the right to lock the legs in place.



3. Turn the hand screw on the pole of the tripod to the left to loosen it.



4. Move the tripod pole up or down to your desired height and turn the hand screw on the tripod to the right to tighten it.



5. Turn the joiner that connects the two halves of the tripod pole to the left to loosen it.



6. Move the tripod pole up or down to your desired height and turn the joiner to the right to tighten it.




### Attach a tablet to the tripod

The tablet holder is designed to hold tablets that are between 7 in. and 10. in. in size.

1. With the tablet screen facing upwards, slide one of the long sides of the tablet into one of the retractable brackets on the tablet holder.



2. Pull out the other retractable bracket to open it up and place the bracket claw over the other side of the tablet. Gently release the bracket.



**Caution!** Make sure that the tablet is securely fixed into the tablet holder before you proceed to the next step and attach the tablet holder to the tripod.

Press and hold the buttons on either side of the attachment at the end of the tripod pole.

4. Align the tablet holder with the attachment at the end of the tripod pole and release the buttons.



## Adjust the tablet holder

The tablet holder moves in 90 degree increments in either direction, so the tablet can be in either landscape or portrait position. To move the tablet holder, grasp the side of the tablet and move it in the direction that you want it to go in. When you have moved the tablet holder 90 degrees, you will hear a click to indicate that the tablet holder is in place.

You can also adjust the angle of the tablet holder by pulling it forward or backward. Additionally, the tablet holder also swivels up to 180 degrees. To move the tablet holder, grasp the side of the tablet and swivel it to the right or left to the position that you want it to be in.

### Remove the tablet

1. Hold the tablet holder while you press and hold the buttons on either side of the attachment at the end of the tripod pole.

Warning! Make sure that you have a secure hold on the tablet holder before you press the buttons.

- Pull the tablet holder off of the tripod pole and release the buttons that you were pressing.
- 3. Pull one of the retractable brackets away from the side of the tablet.
- 4. Slide the tablet out from under the retractable bracket and pull it free from the tablet holder
